

2020 Fire Fighters Golf Tournament

Covid 19 Update

Given the current Covid 19 Environment, it is necessary to make several adjustments to the structure of our Annual Fire Fighters Golf Tournament for 2020. The following outlines the requirements that we will need to follow in order to ensure that we are conforming to the Public Health Regulations.

In this regard, the Host Committee and Fox Meadow Golf Course are requesting everyone's cooperation in ensuring that we have a successful day while strictly adhering to the requirements.

- Rather than the traditional shotgun start where all golfers tee off at the same time, this year we will be staggering the start times. All registered golfers will be divided into 3 smaller groups not exceeding 40 golfers. Start times for the three groups will be 9:00am, 11:00am, and 1:00pm. The groups will be established by the host committee once all teams have been registered. Each Department will be notified of its start time prior to the day of the tournament.
- The BBQ at the Cross Roads Fire Department will not be held this year. In its place, a meal will be provided to each golfer by Hunter's at Fox Meadow immediately following each group's round. Meal times will be staggered as required to ensure that only one group is in the club house at a time. Upon completion of one group's meal, all golfers will be required to leave in order to allow Hunter's to prepare for the next group coming in.
- Prizes will be awarded to the winning team from each group.
- Closes to the hole and longest drive competitions will be held. Prize winners will be determined by the host committee at the end of the day, and all winners will be notified at a later date respectfully.
- All golfers will be expected to respect the Social Distancing Rules and not congregate in large groups
